LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT WREATH

Light the first candle in the Advent wreath.

The prophet Isaiah wrote, "See, I am sending my messenger ahead of you, who will prepare your way; the voice of one crying out in the wilderness: 'Prepare the way of the Lord, make his paths straight."

(Mark 1:2-3, NRSV.)
